

RULES AND ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES

BE RESPONSIBLE, BE RESPECTFUL, BE SAFE = BE NICE & WORK HARD

Level 1 Rules

- Minor Disruptions of the Educational Environment
- 3 Tardies (per trimester for 6-8) K-5 at teachers discretion
- Dress Code Violation
- Littering/spitting
- Unprepared, No Book Cover, No Parent Signature
- Unauthorized Eating or Gum
- Unauthorized Possession or use of an electronic signaling device such as Cell Phones, Pagers, Ipods, MP3 players, CD players, Electronic Games or Laser Pointers. Equipment will be confiscated.
- Entering or Loitering in Unauthorized Areas.
- Inappropriate Open Displays of Affection

Any or all of the following may be applied to the above rules.

Level 1 Consequences

- Verbal warning
- Parent notification by email or regular mail or phone call home
- 2 point loss
- detention
- Possible focus room
- 1 hour after school community service
- Equipment confiscated, Student may retrieve after school
- Equipment confiscated, Parent must retrieve
- 3 behavior reports = referral with a 2 point loss
- Materials confiscated, clothing modified, as appropriate

Level 2 Rules

- Defiance of School Authority
- Major Disruption of the Educational Environment
- Fighting
- Commission of an Obscene Act or Foul Language
- Cheating or Forgery (possible zero on Assignment)
- Attempting to Steal or Stealing Private property or school property or knowingly in possession of stolen school or private property
- Minor Vandalism
- Hostile School Environment or Harassment
- Class Cut or out of class without a pass
- Any repeated Level 1 offenses

Any or all of the following may be applied to the above rules.

Level 2 Consequences

- Administrative conference
- Parent letter and phone call
- Up to 5 school days in-house or home suspension
- 3 - 10 point loss
- Ineligible status for 1 - 4 weeks
- Detention
- Zero on assignment, project, or test
- Student shall be required to pay for loss or damage
- May include Level 1 consequences

Level 3 Rules

- Possession or use of tobacco
- Possession or use of lighter or matches
- Possession or use of alcohol, drugs narcotics or illegally controlled substance or possession of drug paraphernalia or replica of same
- Possession or sales of furnishing of an explosive, firearm, knife, or other dangerous object or replica (except as allowed by E.C. 48900-b)
- Possession of firecrackers or other fireworks or small explosive devices
- Serious or repeated Level 1 or Level 2 offenses.

Any or all of the following may be applied to the above rules.

Level 3 Consequences

- **AUTOMATIC SUSPENSION**
- 10 - 30 point loss
- Student considered for transfer to alternative educational placement
- Possible recommendations by principal to superintendent for expulsion
- Possible referral to law enforcement agency
- May include Level 1 and/or Level 2 consequences

*****ALL RULES APPLY WHILE COMING TO OR GOING FROM SCHOOL, BEFORE, DURING OR AFTER SCHOOL, RIDING ON THE BUS, AND AT SCHOOL SPONSORED ACTIVITIES, WHETHER ON OR OFF CAMPUS.**

*****SUSPENDED STUDENTS MAY BE ALLOWED TO MAKE UP WORK MISSED DURING THE SUSPENSION AT THE DISCRETION OF THE TEACHER.**
